

RULES AND CONDITIONS



- It is the competitors responsibility to familiarise themselves with the rules. All classes will be ran/judged in accordance with the latest BSJA rules except where it may vary in accordance with British Riding Club's official rules.
- Headgear – **A HARD HAT WITH A THREE POINT LINKAGE HARNESS PROPERLY ADJUSTED AND FASTENED MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED.** The hat **MUST** be marked BSEN1384, PAS015, ASTM F1163, SNELL E2001, SN7 3838 1998 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI.
- Body protectors are **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.**
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel/alter the event in any way.
- In public areas of the showground horses/ponies must be ridden or led at walk.
- Please respect the hospitality of landowners and take your litter home or use the bins provided. Do not clean out your horsebox/trailer on the field.
- **No refund** of entry fees will be given.
- **The Judge's decision is final.** Any objections must be handed to the secretary, in writing, with a deposit of £20 within 15 minutes of the concern arising. The deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.
- There will be no Farrier on call at any events so please ensure your horse is suitably shod.
- Dogs **must** be kept on a short lead and under control at all times.
- Young children are to be supervised at all times.
- **HORSES AND PONIES MUST NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN THE LORRY PARK UNLESS SECURED CORRECTLY INSIDE A TRAILER/ HORSEBOX.**
- Age as at 1 January 2008.
- Any horse/pony jumping as a horse/pony must do so for the entire season.
- Any person riding on a lead rein must do so for the rest of the event.
- Non-members riding members horses must pay non-members fees.
- No horse under 4 years of age can be ridden on the showground.

Legal Liability: No responsibility can be taken for theft, loss, damage, accident or illness caused to persons/animals/property or vehicles attending this event.

Health, Safety and Welfare: The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
