Chairman's Bit.....

Well, fantastic news - our Junior Rider's Test Team came first at the National Championships. Thank you to all who have competed on behalf of H&DRC at both Area and National level this year, you've done fantastically well. I must also thank all those who go as drivers, grooms, caterers and general support - you are appreciated! More detailed results can be found in the National Championship report later in this newsletter.

Our usual show jumping competitions have run with a drop off in numbers through June and July possibly owing to the hot weather and hard ground. The End of Season Show was quite well attended, although the Dressage was cancelled owing to poor entries. Results can be found later in the newsletter. Training sessions continue to take place with a regular attendance. We are hoping to continue through the winter, you will find details under "Training" in the newsletter.

The Annual Ball and Trophy Presentation planned for the 7th. October has been cancelled owing to lack of support. Therefore the AGM, which was to have been held on 5th. December, has been moved to 7th December at Allensmore Village Hall in order to incorporate the Trophy Presentation. Please think about coming on the committee, there is a lot to do if the club is to run at it's current rate of activity. This year we have been short of people so the work has rested on a few. It would be better to start 2006 with a full committee, if not I shall have to think of a way to lessen the workload which will inevitably mean that club activities may suffer.

It seems that quite a lot of people are using the web site but only a few have managed to download the newsletter. If you are able to do this, please let us know as we have no way of knowing and it would save money in printing and postage if more members were able to use this facility.

As this is the last newsletter to go out this year, you will find a membership renewal form enclosed - I'm afraid it's that time of year again! It does actually say in the constitution, and I quote " The annual subscription shall be payable on the first day of the Club's financial year (1st November). Any member whose subscription is more than three months in arrears shall have his or her name removed from the membership list after written notice." The committee has opted to keep the subscription the same but to increase the entry fees at shows by £1 and the training sessions to £10 per person (so they pay for themselves). 2005 started in a bit of an administrative muddle so most of you will be thinking that it has come round a bit soon, but really we're proceeding as per the constitution and the sooner the subscriptions are in the better it is for the club.

If I don't see you at the AGM, may I take this opportunity to wish you all a very Happy Christmas and New Year (only twelve weeks from the 1st. October!)

Training sessions through the winter

Training sessions have remained popular - we are hoping to keep going through the winter with monthly flatwork and jumping sessions. These sessions are intended for all riders and horses regardless of age or experience. We do try to group the standards if possible, but we usually find that the instructor is able to tailor the lesson to benefit all participants. As we will be hiring surfaces as well as instructors we will be increasing the charge to £10 per session to cover costs. This will still be good value as the flatwork sessions will be confined to three per session so riders will get some individual attention.

There will be more sessions running from January 2006 - Sally has a small indoor school and Emma Slater is lined up to take some sessions at Caradoc where she can use indoor facilities so only poor driving conditions should stop us.

There was also some response to the suggestion that we run a cross country schooling session if anyone is interested please contact Kirsten as we would need a minimum number of riders to run it and it really needs to take place before the ground gets too wet.

H&DRC Teams 2005...the epic tale!

Last year I seem to remember saying 'what an amazing year' and thought we couldn't do any better, but this year has proved me wrong. Our team competitors have never failed to attend an Area Qualifier without someone winning a red rosette, or a finals without coming home with something.

The Riding Club Teams started the summer season in April, down in Wenvoe with the Hunter Trial Area Qualifier. I just couldn't believe it, as I was unable to go, as my attendance was required at my Uncle's 60th birthday party, I phoned Sarah Heathfield for the low down who said both the Junior and the Senior Teams had won, I couldn't believe it and thought it was the alcohol affecting my hearing, but it wasn't we had won. A few weeks later the teams travelled to Peterborough to compete in the Finals were the Junior Team (Lauren Keen, Louise Pickering, Ilona Gunson and Samantha Brown) just missed out on a placing by finishing 11th, and the Senior Novice Team (Sarah & Rodway Heathfield, Sarah Masefield and Caroline King) sneaked into the placings with a 10th place.

The next Area Qualifier held in June was the Show Jumping, which was hosted by us, at Allensmore. This was another successful day with many placings by H&DRC Team members and many competitors gaining a place at the Riding Club National Championships. We won the Junior and Senior Open Show Jumping, Junior Equitation Jumping, and had individual placings in both the Junior and Senior Novice Show Jumping.

The year continued with the Horse Trials Area Qualifier being held on a very hot day in July at Sapey Cross Country Course, and I ended the day looking like Rudolph as I burnt my nose! This was a repeat of the Hunter Trials as both the Junior and the Senior Team won their respective competitions, and secured a place at the Finals. We also had an Senior Open Placing of 5th by Roland Lee. The Finals followed soon after of Offchurch Bury, where the Senior Novice Team (Sarah & Rodway Heathfield, Sarah Masefield and Jessica Kingston-Schleider) finished in 7th position, with Sarah Masefield and Half n Half also gaining an individual 3rd place. The Junior Team (Samantha Brown, Ilona Gunson, Angela Mace and May Blackman-Howard) finished in 11th place, they also had some individual successes with Ilona Gunson and Black Jet being awarded with the Highest placed ex-racehorse, Angela Mace and Llangarth Phillipa finishing in 4th place and May Blackman-Howard and Laystone Mr Happy finishing in 6th place.

The final area qualifier was the Dressage held in the idyllic setting at Cabalva. Well what can I say other than we were amazing, all we seemed to do was pick up red rosettes. We won the following classes Senior Novice Dressage Team, Senior Open Dressage Team, Senior Riding Test Team, Junior Riding Test Team, Junior Dressage Team and Junior Dressage to Music. We also had a huge number of individual placings. So a number of competitors gained themselves a place at the National Championships.

The National Championships were soon upon us, everything was organised and there we were as dedicated as ever travelling the breadth of the country to the Lincolnshire Showground. The weekend was hectic with 24 horses in attendance, the highest number of horses from any single club may I add. The Saturday was a very wet and dreary day but I didn't deter the competitors from all doing their best and gaining a number of placings. By the end of Day 1 the Senior Open Show Jumping Team (Roland Lee, Ruth Lee, Holly Cartwright and Isobel Lee) worked hard and the course was tough, the ground was getting churned up, but with some very determined riding especially by Ruth Lee the team finished in a respectable 9th position.

The Dressage people were also showing their true form with Sarah Heathfield and ILPH Crumpet had finishing in 6th place in the Senior Riding Test, the Senior Novice Dressage Team (Sarah Heathfield, Isobel Lee, Jessica Kingston-Schleider and Catherine Mace) finished in 4th place, with Isobel Lee and Caple Cavalier finishing individually 6th, Jessica Kingston-Schleider and Llangarth Aisha finishing 6th and Catherine Mace and Riccardo Reashi finishing 10th.

Then came the 2nd day and the sun had come out, this was yet another hectic day but well worth it as we had the ultimate win of all, the Junior Riding Test Team were crowned the 'British Riding Clubs National Champions'. The team comprised of Ilona Gunson and Black Jet, Angela Mace and Riccardo Reashi, Harriet Cattroll-Klymchuk and Millers Spark, and Karen Gardiner and Regal Rumour. The team worked very well together and were supported by Samantha Brown, who was in the qualifying team but unfortunately her horse had sustained an injury the week before the finals and Karen Gardiner took her place admirably. So I would say a huge well done to the '5' individuals who together achieved this success. They also gained some individual placings in this class as Ilona Gunson was 3rd with the highest placed ex-racehorse, Angela Mace was 5th and Harriet Cattroll-Klymchuk also finished in 3rd place.

The same team also went on to finish 3rd in the Junior Team Dressage, with some more individual placings, Ilona Gunson was 3rd with the highest placed ex-racehorse, Angela Mace was 7th and Harriet Cattroll-Klymchuk also finished in 7th place. We also had an individual 9th place for Samantha Brown with Clon Clodiagh in the Junior Dressage as an individual.

Angela Mace and Llangarth Phillipa went on to finish 2nd in the Junior Equitation Jumping. While Glyn Jones and Red Monarch were showing the Evergreen judges that just because you get older doesn't mean you calm down and went on to finish in 6th place.

All that is left to say is 'WELL DONE' to everyone who has made this year a year to remember, not just the competitors but the grooms, drivers, supporters.....and on a final note, let's hope 2006 is just as good!

Notes for Training and Dressage:

Llangarron Court, Llangarron (near Ross-on-Wye) is approximately one-and-a-half miles from the A4137 Hereford-to-Monmouth Road. For further directions please contact a Committee Member.

Warham Court is located in the village of Warham, which is just outside Hereford on the road leading past the Waterworks Museum at Broomy Hill. Some of you may know this as Sally Newcomb's stables.

The parking at Warham Court and Llangarron Court is limited and each venue has just one arena to use for the competition, so to avoid hanging around from one test to the other we propose to run the dressage at these venues in a different way. That is for the competitor to choose two tests out of the four offered, to warm up then enter the arena, inform the judge which tests are being ridden and then perform the two chosen tests consecutively. This will alleviate parking, require only one warm up and save the competitor time hanging around.
