Training

We are very grateful to Fiona Birch for stepping into the role of Training Co-ordinator. She has arranged the following dates:-

Show Jumping with Jolie Smith at Allensmore:-

Tuesday 6th June, Tuesday 11th July, Tuesday 8th August

Four riders per session @ £10 - Sessions starting from 5.30pm

Flatwork with Sally Newcomb at Warham Court:-

Saturday 17th June, Saturday 15th July, Saturday 19th August., Saturday 23rd September

Three riders per session @ £10 - times to be arranged on application.

Cross Country schooling with William Blane:-

Tuesday 13th June at Hilltop

Thursday 20th July at Sapey plus Show Jumping if desired.

Tuesday 8th August at Dulas plus Show Jumping if desired.

All these sessions will be £10 plus the hire of the course at £12 per horse but this may differ in the case of a group hire. Times will depend on when the majority of people can get to the venue. If you are interested in booking in please contact Fiona.

Dressage judge and instructor, Louise Manning has offered the following dates to run a course on improving your dressage test from the judges point of view :-

Saturday 8th July, Sunday 23rd July, Saturday 26th August

Louise intends to cover transitions, use music to work on rhythm and paces which may also encourage people to have a go at Dressage to Music. Three riders per session @ £10 plus arena hire starting from 3.00pm onwards. The venue has yet to be confirmed, please contact Fiona if you are interested in taking part.

We have experienced some problems with cancellations recently which does give the organiser a headache. Therefore, bookings will only be confirmed when payment is made and if you have to cancel and there is no-one on the waiting list to take your place, your money may not be returned.

In addition to the above there has been a request for very basic jumping i.e. trotting poles and crosspoles. Good for not only geriatric or nervous horses/riders but can help horses/riders understand rhythm and calmness required for more ambitious jumping. Again, contact Fiona if you are interested and she will be happy to arrange something.
